Important Information regarding our Three Way Conferences



Written Reports - will be sent home on Wednesday 20th July.

Three-Way Conferences – will take place on Thursday, 21st July between 8.00am – 7.00 pm.

On this day your child comes to <u>The Three Way Conference</u> and then goes home.

General outline of the Three-Way Conference

- Student shares some examples of their learning.
 Parent/Carer, student and teacher look at samples of student learning.
 - PLEASE arrive promptly for your child's conference.
- 2. Student and teacher discuss student learning and future goals.
- 3. Parents/carers comment and ask questions.
- 4. This conference will be for 18 minutes.

Three-Way Conferences – Why do we do this?

We implement this approach because:

- The student reflects on his/her learning and sets goals, which is part of life-long learning.
- Parent/carers, teachers and students, have an open and supportive discussion about the child's learning.
- Children's education is enhanced when students, parents and teachers work together in a positive partnership.
- <u>The Three-Way Conference</u> is an opportunity to celebrate the student's achievements.
- <u>The Three Way Conference</u> encourages the student to take responsibility for their learning.

Student Goals

- Setting goals is a very important part of life.
- When students set goals, they become active participants in their learning process.
- At *Mildura West Primary School*, we encourage and support our students to take responsibility for their own learning.
- Teachers explicitly teach students how to reflect and set goals.
- Student goals will be discussed in the Three-Way Conference.

What is the Parent/Carer's role in Three-Way Conferencing?

- To make this time special, please leave all children/siblings in the crèche (In the library). This will support the process & make it a special time for the child in the Conference.
- Listen carefully to your child as he/she talks about his/her learning.
- Encourage your child throughout the conference.
- Ask specific questions to truly understand the student's learning.
- Focus on what your child can do and has achieved.
- Compliment your child on a job well done at the conclusion of the conference.

NOTE: If there are any delicate issues you wish to discuss with the teacher privately, teachers will be happy to meet with you at another time.
